

## **Equipment, Processes & Buildings**

- Three year planning and investment = over \$100,000
  - Safety
  - Technology
  - Emergency communications
  - Including:
    - Installation of two-way Video Doorbell System
    - Replaced locks and keys around entire campus all doors
    - New lockdown exterior lights



## **Equipment & Buildings**

- Reduced multi-step process to single step
  - Previous process:
    - Text message from computer
    - Email message from computer
    - Call 911
    - Outside lights station with key



## **Equipment & Buildings**

#### Improved processes:

- Lockdown button activated; message sent to Rapid Response, then calls 911.
- Text messages/emails are generated at the same time to faculty and staff
- Notification sent to all laptops
- Notifications sent to all LSI TVs & "clocks"
- Outside lights activated



## **Prepare**

#### Safety remotes:

- Programmed
- Tagged
- Placed in each building

#### Strobe lights added:

- Outside Walden
- Near pool

## Run, Hide, Fight Train the Trainer

Why Run, Hide, Fight



## Run, Hide, Fight

- Train the trainers:
  - Annual training to ensure core group of trainers (currently 12)
  - Recertification every two years
- Run, Hide, Fight training offered monthly-new staff



### Run or Hide?

Several questions were asked regarding whether to Run or Hide:

- related to students (and patients) who are not physically able to run
- young children
- children who are afraid to run

In these instances, LOCKDOWN is the safest option



## **Drills and Testing**

- Quarterly drills and equipment testing Drills with adults (most recent one was today)
- Each time new equipment was added, test to ensure everything working properly
- Planning for drill with students



## Next steps: drill with students

- Preparation:
  - Communication with families/parents/caregivers
  - Explain to students what to expect and why
  - Debriefing after drill
